**ORDER MODIFYING PRELIMINARY APPROVAL ORDER,
NOTICE PLAN, AND SHORT FORM NOTICE**

Plaintiff Alyssa Polacsek, along with plaintiffs-in-intervention, Sarah Leoni and Felecia Robinson (collectively referred to as "Plaintiffs") have moved the Court an order modifying the preliminary approval order entered herein on June 23, 2006 (Document 442), Plaintiffs' Proposed Notice Plan (Document # 436, Ex. 4) and the short form notice (Document 436 Ex. 6). Class Counsel previously notified the Court of a discrepancy in the data possessed by class counsel and the data possessed by the FTC concerning the identities of AmeriDebt class members. In the follow-up motion, Plaintiffs set forth proposed modifications to the notice to authorize the distribution of notice to approximately 82,011 "new" class members. The Court hereby GRANTS the said motion as set forth below:

1. This Order pertains only to the approximately 82,011 class members as determined by Rosenthal & Co. whose identifying data was not delivered to Rosenthal & Co. until on or about July 12, 2006 (the "New" Class Members).
2. Notice by mail and electronic mail to the "New" Class Members shall be completed in accordance with the notice plan and on or before August 4, 2006.

3. Any "New" Class Member who objects to approval of the proposed Settlements may appear at the final approval hearing in person or through counsel to show cause why the proposed settlement agreements should not be approved as fair, reasonable, and adequate. However, no such person may be heard at the final approval hearing, or file papers or briefs, unless on or before September 8, 2006 such person files and serves on counsel a timely written objection and notice of intent to appear, in accordance with this Court's rules for filing pleadings. Any "New" Class Member that does not make his or her objection to the Settlements in the manner provided herein, shall be deemed to have waived such objection.


4. Therefore, Objections to the settlement and notices of intention to appear at the final approval hearing shall be deemed timely only if postmarked on or before September 8, 2006.

5. Class Counsel shall file their response, if any, and any papers in support of final approval of the settlement on or before September 15, 2006.

6. The standard form of short form notice (Document 436-6) delivered to such persons by mail or email shall be modified to provide that objections from such class members may be submitted through September 8, 2006.

7. The final approval hearing shall remain scheduled for September 18, 2006 at 11:30 a.m. before the honorable Peter J. Messitte, 6500 Cherrywood Ave., Greenbelt, MD 20770, at a courtroom to be announced on the PolacsekClass.com website.
